Outer County Evidence Presentation Cart Information (NOMAD)

NOTE: This information sheet applies to Baker, Gilchrist and Levy County. Bradford County has a built-in setup in the courtroom. All cables are located on the attorney tables.

If you have any questions, would like to reserve, and/or schedule a free training on the NOMAD email the Court Technology Help Desk at cthelp@circuit8.org or give us a call at 352-374-3655. Training is highly recommended before using the NOMAD, as court technology staff does not assist in your presentation. This should be done at least one-week prior to the event.

The Evidence Presentation Cart, commonly known as the NOMAD, comes equipped with a projector, computer, CD/DVD player and video arm. The NOMAD also has speakers and a VGA cable attached to connect a separate laptop. However, there are few things to keep in mind if you are connecting your own laptop:

1. The laptop **must** have a VGA port, as shown below:



2. The NOMAD is <u>not</u> compatible with Apple devices unless you have the Apple VGA convertor shown below



Again, the NOMAD does come equipped with a computer. If you are missing all of the above, we suggest that you bring the files or videos you need on a USB drive as backup.
