

RULE 3.030

NOTICE TO SHOW CAUSE

1. The Clerk of this Court shall cause NOTICE TO APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE to be served upon any payor fourteen (14) days in arrears, who is required by court to make alimony, separate maintenance or child support payments through the Domestic Relations Department.

2. Such NOTICE shall advise the defaulting payor the amount of his arrearage and set a time certain for his appearance in court to show cause why he should not be adjudged in contempt of court and punished accordingly.

3. There shall be a service charge of \$5.00 to be paid by the defaulting payor to the Clerk for expenses incurred in serving the NOTICE TO APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE.

4. Testimony or a certificate of the Clerk showing that certified mail containing Notice to Appear and Show Cause addressed to the last known residence of the payor has been returned unclaimed shall be prima facie evidence that the payor is secreting him/herself from the service of court process, and shall subject said payor to immediate arrest and/or attachment. Further, he/she shall be subject to contempt proceedings for failure to comply with the order to notify the Clerk of the change in his/her residence address.
