ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 12.02

ALACHUA COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD QUALIFIED ELECTOR


WHEREAS, section 102.141(1)(d), Florida Statutes, provides that when a substitute member or alternate member cannot be appointed to the county canvassing board as provided elsewhere in the statute's subsection, the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint as a substitute member or alternate member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed; and

WHEREAS, an alternate member is not able to be appointed to the county canvassing board as provided elsewhere in section 102.141(1), and it is necessary to appoint a qualified elector as an alternate member to the county canvassing board in and for Alachua County, Florida;

WHEREAS, The Honorable Kristine Van Vorst, Alachua County Court Judge, is a qualified elector of Alachua County, Florida, and is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed, and is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed; it is therefore

ORDERED that The Honorable Kristine Van Vorst, Alachua County Court Judge, is hereby appointed as an alternate member to the county canvassing board as a qualified elector in and for Alachua County, Florida, beginning on October 18, 2018, until the end of the 2018 election cycle and all post-election canvassing board meetings pertaining thereto.
