

THE EIGHTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 12.03

BAKER COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD

WHEREAS, section 102.141(1), Florida Statutes provides that a county court judge shall serve as a member and chair of the county canvassing board; and


WHEREAS, section 102.141(1)(e), Florida Statutes, provides that the chief judge shall appoint a county court judge or qualified elector as an alternate member of the canvassing board. In the event that a member of the canvassing board is unable to participate at a meeting, the chair of the county canvassing board may designate the alternate member to serve in their place.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint a county court judge and an alternate to the county canvassing board in and for Baker County, Florida; it is therefore

ORDERED that the Honorable Joseph M. Williams, Baker County Court Judge, is hereby appointed as a member and the chair of the county canvassing board in and for Baker County, Florida. It is further

ORDERED that Frank Maloney, Esquire, is hereby appointed as alternate canvassing board member in and for Baker County, Florida.
