

THE EIGHTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 12.01 (v7)

ALACHUA COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD

WHEREAS, section 102.141(1), Florida Statutes provides that a county court judge shall serve as a member and chair of the county canvassing board; and


WHEREAS, section 102.141(1)(e), Florida Statutes, provides that the chief judge shall appoint a county court judge or qualified elector as an alternate member of the canvassing board. In the event that a member of the canvassing board is unable to participate at a meeting, the chair of the county canvassing board may designate the alternate member to serve in their place.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint a county court judge and alternates to the county canvassing board in and for Alachua County, Florida; it is therefore

ORDERED that the Honorable Thomas M. Jaworski, Alachua County Court Judge, is hereby appointed as a member and the chair of the county canvassing board in and for Alachua County, Florida. It is further

ORDERED that the Honorable Susan Miller-Jones, Alachua County Court Judge, is hereby appointed as alternate canvassing board member in and for Alachua County, Florida; and the Honorable Kristine Van Vorst, Alachua County Court Judge, is hereby appointed as second alternate canvassing board member in and for Alachua County, Florida.
