

THE EIGHTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA  
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 12.05

**GILCHRIST COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD**

**WHEREAS**, section 102.141(1), Florida Statutes provides that a county court judge shall serve as a member and chair of the county canvassing board; and


**WHEREAS**, section 102.141(1)(e), Florida Statutes, provides that the chief judge shall appoint a county court judge or qualified elector as an alternate member of the canvassing board. In the event that a member of the canvassing board is unable to participate at a meeting, the chair of the county canvassing board may designate the alternate member to serve in their place.

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to appoint a county court judge and an alternate to the county canvassing board in and for Gilchrist County, Florida; it is therefore

**ORDERED** that the Honorable Sheree H. Lancaster, Gilchrist County Court Judge, is hereby appointed as a member and the chair of the county canvassing board in and for Gilchrist County, Florida. It is further

**ORDERED** that Robert E. Willis, Esquire, is hereby appointed as alternate canvassing board member in and for Gilchrist County, Florida.
