

THE EIGHTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA  
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 12.09

**IN RE: BRADFORD COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD SUBSTITUTE MEMBER  
APPOINTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, section 102.141(1), Florida Statutes, provides that if neither a county court judge nor the alternate canvassing board member is able to serve or is disqualified, the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint as a substitute member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed, and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed; and,

**WHEREAS**, since neither Bradford County court judge Richard B. Davis, Jr., nor alternate canvassing board member, James A. Davis, Jr., is able to serve, The Honorable Ray Norman, a qualified elector of Bradford County, Florida, who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed, and not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed, has agreed to serve as a Substitute Member; it is therefore

**ORDERED** that The Honorable Ray Norman is hereby appointed as a substitute member to the county canvassing board in and for Bradford County, Florida, beginning on November 2, 2016, until the end of the 2016 election cycle.
