

THE EIGHTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA  
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 12.11

**IN RE: ALACHUA COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD SUBSTITUTE MEMBER  
APPOINTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, section 102.141(1)(d), Florida Statutes, provides that in the event of a vacancy in the office of the substitute canvassing board member, the chief judge of the judicial circuit in which the county is located shall appoint as a substitute member or alternate member a qualified elector of the county who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed; and

**WHEREAS**, substitute canvassing board member Tony Domenech, will be unable to serve between 9:00 a.m. and 11:59 p.m. on November 18, 2016, The Honorable Lee Pinkoson, a qualified elector of Alachua County, Florida, who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed, and not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed, has agreed to serve as the Substitute Member; it is therefore

**ORDERED** that The Honorable Lee Pinkoson is hereby appointed as the substitute member to the county canvassing board in and for Alachua County, Florida, beginning at 9:00 a.m. on November 18, 2016, and ending at 11:59 p.m. on November 18, 2016, at which time Mr. Tony Domenech will continue in his appointment as substitute member until the end of the 2016 election cycle.
