ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 12.12

**ALACHUA COUNTY CANVASSING BOARD SUBSTITUTE MEMBER AND  
ALTERNATE MEMBER APPOINTMENT**

**WHEREAS**, section 102.141(1), Florida Statutes provides that the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners, or a member of the Board, shall serve as a member of the county canvassing board; and

**WHEREAS**, in the event that neither the Chair, nor any member of the Board is able to serve as a member of the county canvassing board, the chief judge shall appoint a substitute member of the canvassing board who shall be a qualified elector of the county, who is not a candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed, and who is not an active participant in the campaign or candidacy of any candidate with opposition in the election being canvassed; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to appoint a substitute member of the Alachua County Canvassing Board, in that neither the Chair of the Alachua County Board of County Commissioners nor any member of the Board are able to serve; and

**WHEREAS**, it is also necessary to appoint an alternate substitute member of the Alachua County Canvassing Board, in the event the substitute member is unable to serve.

It is therefore

**ORDERED** that Penny Wheat is hereby appointed as substitute member of the Alachua County Canvassing Board, commencing with the entry of this Order and continuing through the conclusion of the 2022 election cycle. It is further

**ORDERED** that Mike Byerly is hereby appointed as alternate substitute member of the Alachua County Canvassing Board, commencing with the entry of this Order and continuing through the conclusion of the 2022 election cycle, and shall serve if the substitute member is unable to serve.
