ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 4.20

**DISBURSEMENT OF UNCLAIMED COURT-ORDERED RESTITUTION PAYMENTS
COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS**

WHEREAS, section 775.089, Florida Statutes, provides the Courts to order restitution in certain circumstances; and

WHEREAS, section 948.032, Florida Statutes, provides that if a defendant is placed on probation, any restitution ordered under section 775.089, Florida Statutes, shall be a condition of probation; and

WHEREAS, section 945.31(3), Florida Statutes, provides that if the Department of Corrections is unable to locate the person or organization designated by the court to receive the payment of restitution, or if the designated payee refuses to accept the payment, the Department of Corrections is authorized to deposit or transfer into the General Revenue Fund the unclaimed payments;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

In all counties within the Eighth Judicial Circuit, the Department of Corrections shall remit unclaimed restitution payments to the General Revenue Fund of the State of Florida.
