HEARING OFFICER**


WHEREAS, the Chief Judge is authorized to appoint Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officers within the circuit to address Title IV-D proceedings pursuant to Florida Family Law Rule of Procedure 12.491; outbreak of COVID-19 has caused a public health emergency; and

WHEREAS, Katherine L. Floyd is currently an Eighth Judicial Circuit General Magistrate and is qualified to serve as a Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officer;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Katherine L. Floyd is appointed as Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officer in the Eighth Judicial Circuit to perform the duties and possess the powers as provided by Florida Family Law Rule of Procedure 12.491.
2. This Order is effective immediately.




