NOMAD

The Alachua Family Civil Justice Center has two Evidence Presentation Carts, commonly known as the NOMAD. One comes equipped with a projector, computer, CD/DVD player and video arm. The other comes equipped with a projector, computer, and video arm. We suggest that you bring the files or videos you need on a USB drive as backup. The NOMAD also has speakers and a multimedia cable attached to connect a separate laptop. There are a few things to keep in mind if you are connecting your own laptop:

1. The laptop **must** have a VGA port, a DisplayPort or an HDMI port as shown below:



LCD TELEVISION

The Alachua Civil Justice Center also has two LCD TV's on rolling stands can be connected to a laptop.
