GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The essential function of this position is to assist the court by managing and monitoring guardianship and foreclosure proceedings in the Eighth Circuit. The position is responsible for tracking the progress of cases, setting them for hearings, assuring that orders are prepared and signed, and for maintaining databases as needed for reporting purposes. Work will involve dealing with judges, magistrates, court administration, attorneys, and members of the public. This position is based in Alachua County, though some travel around the circuit may be required. The position works under the supervision of the Court Operations Director.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES

Working knowledge of trial court rules and procedures. Ability to work with minimal supervision and establish work priorities. Ability to handle sensitive matters with integrity and utmost confidentiality. Excellent oral and written communication skills. Maintain a professional and courteous demeanor when dealing with distressed individuals. Proficient in Microsoft Office applications and operation of standard office equipment.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE

An Associate's degree from an accredited college or university and one year of experience in administrative work. Relevant experience may substitute for the educational requirement.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

Salary is \$36,115/annually. This is a state-funded position with State of Florida retirement benefits.
